Our Mission

The C.F.F. Ministry of St. Paul Church, inspired by the love of Jesus Christ, is committed to build a solid faith foundation for the children, youth, and adults in the parish.

Who We Are

We are St. Paul parishioners who are committed to proclaim the Good News and to bring about in all believers a deeper knowledge of Jesus Christ, a trusting relationship with him, a firm commitment to follow him, and a greater participation in the Christian life in the Church.

What We Do

We conduct regular faith formation sessions for Pre-School Children to Eighth Grade Children & those who have received their Confirmation on Sundays at 10:00-11:00 A.M. / 11:00-12:00 Noon / 12:00-1:00 P.M.

We prepare older children to receive the Sacrament of Baptism.

Children 10 to 15 years old and their parents and Godparents attend a two-year RCIA process adapted for children on Wednesdays at 6:30 to 7:30 P.M. Baptism takes place during the Easter Vigil.

Children 16-17 years old and their parents and Godparents attend a two-year RCIA process adapted for teens on Thursdays at 7:30 P.M. to 9:00 P.M. . Baptism takes place during the Easter Vigil.

We prepare children for the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist.

2nd Grade Children receive their First Reconciliation and First Eucharist after they have completed two years of Faith Formation.

3rd – 4th Grade Children undergo a two-year preparation for them to receive their First Reconciliation and First Eucharist. After they have received these sacraments they join their respective regular grade levels on the following year for their Faith Formation class.

5th to 10th Grade Children undergo a two-year RCIA process held on Wednesdays at 6:30 to 7:30 P.M.

11th to 12th Grade Teens will join the adults in the two-year RCIA process held on Thursdays at 7:30 to 9:00 P.M.

We prepare children and youth to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation.

8th Grade Children receive Confirmation after completing a two-year Confirmation preparation. They are required to perform 20 hours of community service and participate in a weekend retreat (Friday evening to Sunday afternoon).

9th to 10th Grade Teen undergo a two-year RCIA process held on Wednesdays at 6:30 to 7:30 P.M.

11th to 12th Grade Teens join the adults in the two-year RCIA process held on Thursdays at 7:30 to 9:00 P.M.

We nourish the faith journey of our youth and integrate them into active parish life.

We offer ongoing faith formation sessions to parents to enable them to become the most influential agents of catechesis for their children.

We make available adult enrichment processes to those who seek to understand more about their Catholic faith.

How You Can Join Us

You are all welcome to join us in the C.F.F. Ministry. You will be assisted in your discernment of the vocation to be a catechist.

Volunteers are needed for all classes and activities. We encourage you to join us.
